Maintain a leadership role for a group of goalies assigned at check in. • Follow all camp policies, rules and regulations as prescribed by the Director and Staff Assistant. • Supervise and assist your roll call group in all off-field activities, including walking to and from meals and camp sessions. • Teach in session areas; supervise recreational activities, and be present during evening programs • Provide support and be a role model to roll call members. Answer any camp or goalie questions. • Evaluate activities and growth of campers at the end of each session and be able to provide feedback to the camp Director. • Be present in the dorms before and after sessions to help campers around the dorm. • Be punctual and expect to perform dorm duty requirements to include assuring presence of all campers at meals and on-field sessions. • PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. • The employee frequently is required to instruct & shoot on goalies throughout the week in potentially hot conditions.
