In honor of Robert's dedication to the sport he was passionate about playing and coaching, he will be forever remembered through the 6x6 Goalie Camp and Goalies Matter. In honor of Robert we will be awarding two lucky individuals, (1) boy and (1) girl, a scholarship to attend the 6x6 Goalie Camp located at Hope College in Holland, MI. This scholarship will not only provide financial assistance, but also provide two goalies the opportunity to gain valuable goalie knowledge, goalie skills, mental health assistance, and leadership qualities required to be a successful goalie and Leader. Applications will be processed for approval by the 6x6 Goalie Academy Scholarship Committee on a first-come, first-serve basis. Scholarship funds are limited to the 6x6 Goalie Camp ONLY and will provide entrance into the camp and include Lodging on campus, Meals, and a Camp Jersey in honor of Robert.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- A completed application must be submitted to the 6x6 Goalie Academy Scholarship Committee through the link provided.
- A brief essay explaining the reasons why and how this scholarship will benefit you. How you handle pressure you face as a goalie or personally; and how receiving this scholarship will make an impact on your outlook on mental health.
- The applicant must agree that the participant is willing and able to attend a minimum of 80% of camp dates. Failure to attend at least 80% of camp dates will disqualify the family from future award opportunities.

DISCLAIMER: *Understand that if you are selected to receive this scholarship, you completely 100% understand who you will be representing and the impact this scholarship will have on you. This is not a FREE ride into camp, you will be attending camp in Honor of Robert Martin.*
